3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

To support farmers, particularly economically weak men/women and marginal farmers, by assisting them in agricultural activities, marketing their produce, and procuring necessary inputs. It will promote the welfare of agricultural workers, farmers, and labourers by improving their living and working conditions. The organization will facilitate the formation of groups for farmers, women, youth, the elderly, and other community members to encourage collaboration and empowerment. It aims to develop and mobilize community and natural resources to uplift marginalized and economically weaker sections of society. Additionally, it will process, preserve, and store agricultural produce such as fruits, vegetables, and herbs to enhance their utilization and marketability. The organization will also provide consultancy and assistance to farmers, gardeners, and dairy producers to improve their productivity and efficiency. Furthermore, it will disseminate information on new policies and procedures for the organic production of crops, promoting sustainable agricultural practices. All these

activities shall be conducted without any profit motive and exclusively for charitable purposes.

(b) \*Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To establish, acquire, run, aid, maintain educational, skill development, vocational, livelihood, employment generation, rural development and technical training institutions, universities, boarding house, residential accommodation, employment generation facilities / activities, social institutions.
2. To help alleviate poverty by enabling access to the basic necessities of life including clean, safe and nutritious food, clean and safe drinking water, shelter, education and livelihoods for people deprived from such access.
3. To act as developmental bridge in promoting social justice, communal harmony, integrated social development, equality and brotherhood.
4. To Spread of human rights awareness amongst the masses and encourage the efforts of all stake holders in the field of human rights.
5. To establish, acquire, run, aid, maintain healthcare facilities to public.
6. To establish training and service provider institutions in the sector of healthcare.
7. To promote traditional medicinal sciences like yoga, naturopathy, meditation acupressure, acupuncture, massage therapy, Ayurveda, homeopathy, electro homeopathy, reiki, complementary, medicine, traditional medicine / integrated medicine etc.
8. To impart First Aid Training medical check camp, blood donation camp, awareness camp.
9. To free

accommodations for visually impaired/ handicapped, providing all assistive devices to visually impaired, training so that to bring all visually handicapped in the main stream with people.

10. To act for protection and promotion of traditional indigenous knowledge culture, arts, music, philosophy and such other subjects enriching the body and the minds of the people. To provide a philanthropic platform for marginalized destitute communities and their families to express their stories and advocate issues of their concern; to create and disseminate content through various media.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

5 (i) The profits, if any, or other income and property of the company, when-so-ever derived, shall be applied, solely for the promotion of its objects as set forth in this memorandum.

(ii) No portion of the profits, other income or property aforesaid shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise by way of profit, to persons who, at any time are, or have been, members of the company or to any one or more of them or to any persons claiming through any one or more of them.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company

6 No alteration shall be made to this memorandum of association or to the articles of association of the company which are for the time being in force, unless the alteration has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar.

Once at least in every year, the accounts of the company shall be examined, and the correctness of the balance-sheet and the income and expenditure account ascertained by one or more properly qualified auditor or auditors

10 If upon a winding up or dissolution of the company, there remains, after the satisfaction of all the debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be distributed amongst the members of the company but shall be given or transferred to such other company having objects similar to the objects of this company, subject to such conditions as the Tribunal may impose, or may be sold and proceeds thereof credited to the Rehabilitation and Insolvency Fund formed under Section 269 of the Act.

11 The Company can be amalgamated only with another company registered under section 8 of the Act and having similar objects.
